## **District 4 School Highlights**

- Flamingo Elementary School On January 14, 2014, fifth grade students engaged in an environmental educational adventure actively participating in the WaterVentures Florida Learning Lab. The WaterVentures Florida Learning Lab is an interactive lab that provides students with hands-on activities focusing on Florida's diverse watersheds, water conservation and recycling.
- M.A. Milam K-8 Center On January 11, and January 12, 2014, the chess team participated in the South Florida Regional Chess Championship, which took place at the Double Tree by Hilton Miami Airport Convention Center. Seventeen students competed in four divisions. The school earned two team trophies: 3rd place in the K-3 Unrated Division (students who participated for the first time) and 4th place in the K-3 Veteran Players Division.
- Henry H. Filer Middle School On January 13, 2014, 8th grade gifted science students had a chance to participate in a field-trip to Miami-Dade College. The students were given a tour of the new Science Complex Building. While on tour, the students participated in a DNA lab experiment. The students paired up with other 8th grade students from the District and learned how to collect DNA from strawberries.
- Hialeah Gardens Senior High School has opened the Garden Sprouts Preschool. As part of the Academy of Education (an academy that enhances high school students in the pursuit of a career in education), its on-campus preschool provides a full learning experience with labs to get hands-on experience in teaching and learning. High school students are able to earn state certifications, college credits and scholarship opportunities.
