

Summary of visit/required follow-up	We reviewed the Grade 5 Science Winter Interim results. Grade 5 Science satisfactory level was at 21%. We identified weakest benchmarks to be addressed under intervention program which will be held Monday and Thursday 3:00 – 4:00 pm. We also identified the top 45% of students that will participate in the intervention program. We also identified the following resources to be used during intervention: Gizmos, FCAT Explorer, BrainPop, Extended Learning Modules and Focus Achieve. Ms. Tweedy and iHEAT CSS will assist with developing the intervention plan. Strengths: • Intervention had already initiated; however, we identified benchmarks to be addressed. One of the grade 5 teachers will lead the intervention program. •Meeting was very productive and administration is very supportive of the need to establish a targeted intervention plan. •Weaknesses: Grade 5 teachers are two weeks behind in the Pacing Guide. Follow Up: •School will

	provide a schedule for Grade 5 students to use computer lab for use of instructional technology. •Ms. Tweedy and iHeat CSS will assist with developing intervention plan •Ms. Tweedy will continue to provide pushin support to Grade 5 classes •Administrative team will continue to monitor implementation of action steps of the implementation plan.
