ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All Miami-Dade County Public Schools students enrolled in grades 1-12 are eligible.

CONTEST REGULATIONS

All essays must comply with the following contest rules before submission:

- Only one (1) essay may be submitted by each contestant.
- Essay can be written about a grandparent living or deceased.
- Essay must reflect contestant's own writing and original thinking.
- Essays must be written in English.
- Essays must be typed or legibly handwritten.

• Essay word by school level: Up to 300 words for Elementary Up to 500 words for Middle Up to 750 words for Senior High

JUDGING

Judging will be completed by a panel of M-DCPS employees and community partners. Scoring criteria will be identical for all divisions (Elementary, Middle, and Senior High) of the contest. Essays will be judged using five criteria:

- Level of impact, influence, and significance: 40 points
- Creativity (phrasing and style): 30 points
- Grammar, Punctuation, Spelling: 30 points

AWARDS

The top entry in each division will receive a prize package of local experiences for six members of their family. The winning essays will also be featured on the District's website. District winners are expected be announced and honored in March 2014.

SUBMISSIONS

Essays may be submitted one of three ways:

WHO?


Men and women with grandchildren attending Miami-Dade County **Public Schools are encouraged** to participate, along with their grandchildren.
