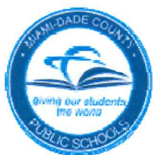
### ■ The Parent Academy

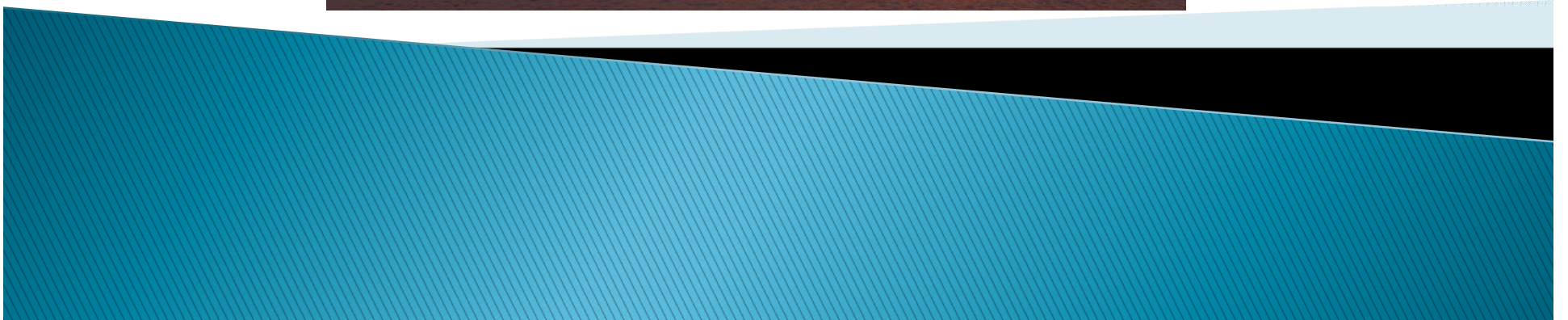


# Recruiting Partners
